## NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISPOSE OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY

Pursuant to ORS 98.245, notice is given that the Linn County Sheriff's Office has in its physical possession the unclaimed personal property described below. If you have any ownership interest in any of that unclaimed property, you must file a written claim with the Linn County Sheriff's Office at the address stated below within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice, or you will lose your interest in that property. Sufficient description of the property to establish with reasonable certainty that the person claiming the property is the owner must be presented.
