Scope of Work

The purpose of the detention pond is to alleviate flooding. It is used as an overflow reservoir when the ditch & stream have reached capacity, backflowing into the pond. When the water level reduces, the water in the detention pond will move back out of the pond and drain into the stream.

The goal of the project is to clear vegetation to access the detention pond and reduce overgrowth to complete the project. The entrance/exit pipes need to be located and cleared. The pond needs to be dug deeper to ensure water moves in and out of the detention pond during flood events.

The ditch along 21st Street needs to be cleared of vegetation overgrowth, which is preventing good stormwater runoff.

Summary

1. Clear vegetation from around detention pond
2. Dig detention pond deeper
3. Locate stormwater pipes entering/exiting detention pond
4. Clear vegetation in ditch along 21st Street
5. Dispose of vegetation, debris, sediment etc off-site
