State Revenue Sharing Hearing: Mayor Valentine opens the State Revenue Sharing Hearing at 6:33pm. Valentine reads Resolution 558-2021 and Resolution 559-2021 by title only. Brenda Harris would like to see the Summer Reading Program brought back to the library, unable to do so due to ADA and covid issues.

There were no changes to the proposed budget recommended.

No additional comments were made from the committee or the public.

Michael Wagner motioned to approve the proposed budget as presented, for the 2021 - 2022 fiscal year at the rate of 1.8926 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operating purposes – Ginger Griffith seconds – motion passed with all in favor. President Jessica Ritchie noted that Lloyd Valentine abstained.
