**Consent Agenda:** Council Meeting Minutes October 24, 2023, and Bills Paid October 25, 2023 – November 28, 2023. *Councilor Ritchie motioned to approve – Councilor Wagner second – All in favor – none opposed – approved.*

## **Unfinished Business:**

- American Rescue Plan (ARP) Update Freres Park Improvements. The parking lot, storm drainage, and concrete pathway have been completed. The building permit has been submitted to Linn County for the shelter just waiting for their approval.
- ALA Grant Received a verbal quote from Amramp at least \$60,000. They want engineered plans and county approval. Will continue working on this.
- Safe Routes to School Engineer of Record In order to proceed with the project a new contract with the engineer is needed. An RFP was issued. The committee: Amy Watts, Dave Kinney & Micki Valentine, reviewed the submission and determined that Civil West best fits the City's needs and recommends that Lyons City Council appoint Civil West as the City's Engineer of Record & allow the City Manager to sign the

agreement, and approve the SRTS Task Order. Councilor Wagner confirms this is money we've already been awarded and no additional funds needed. *Councilor Wagner motioned to approve the recommendation – Councilor Hyde seconded – all in favor – none opposed.- passed.* 

- Ordinance 246-2023 Amending the City of Lyons Municipal Code 8.20.010, Prohibited Camping; 8.10.155, Unattended Property Prohibited; and Repealing Section 9.15, Curfew, to Ensure Compliance with the Requirements of ORS 195.530 Second reading of the ordinance. Brings us in to compliance with state law. Mayor Valentine read by title only. The Sheriff is not present tonight. Councilor Ritchie motioned to approve – Councilor Wagner seconded – all in favor – none opposed – passed.
- **Resolution 593-2023 Authorize Donation Expenditure** This resolution creates a new fund and authorizes the expenditure of donated funds from Freres Foundation *Councilor Ritchie motions to approve Councilor Wagner seconded all in favor none opposed passed*.
- **Resolution 594-2023** Appropriation Transfer within funds to move Capital Outlay funds to Materials & Services within the General Fund, American Rescue Plan Fund, and the Safe Routes to School Fund *Councilor Ritchie motioned to approve Councilor Wagner seconded carried with all in favor none opposed passed.*

# New Business:

- The 2024 budget calendar and 2024 calendar were provided.
- Joint Meeting of Lyons City Council & the Local Contract Review Board opened at 6:55pm by Mayor Valentine. This meeting was held to review changes to public contracting rules and make recommended changes. *Councilor Ritchie motioned to approve Resolution 595-2023 Amending Public Contracting Rules for the City of Lyons – Councilor Hyde seconded – all in favor – none opposed – passed.* Mayor Valentine closed the joint meeting and reopened the Regular City Council meeting at 6:58pm.

**Librarian Report**: Librarian Wilcox provided the report. New books are coming in and being reserved. In the check-out system, she placed a 3-month reservation hold so that only local patrons could reserve the new books during that time. She attended several meetings. The libraries were made aware of a bootlegging scam for DVD materials. The CCRLS App has crashed and may take up to a year for a replacement system. CCRLS is considering a Saturday courier route.

**City Manager Report**: CM Valentine gave report. Public Works Favor is off the season. Berkey working on adjusting shelves at the library. One burial. Flags were placed/removed for the Veteran's holiday. Need to replace library back door and paint the other doors. Increase in mechanical/plumbing permits. The LGIP interest remains unchanged. Requested quotes for a tree removal at the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> and Juniper Street. Selected R&R who will be out in January to remove the tree. The neighbor will be notified when the time gets closer. Will be applying for a .gov web domain in January. Holiday lighting contest in progress. Business license renewal notices went in the mail. Reminder of City Manager vacation. Follow-up provided on a complaint. The City Manager requests that Mayor Valentine be authorized to sign checks. The City Manager reads each check payee names and the amount being paid. *Councilor Hyde motions to approve – then amends for listed checks – one time authorization – Councilor Ritchie seconds and adds bills for the month of December – Councilors Hyde, Ritchie, Wagner, & Watts approve – Mayor Valentine abstained – motion passed.*
