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RESOLUTION No. 641-2026

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF LYONS EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Lyons is vulnerable to earthquake, fire, flood, terrorism and other serious hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyons potentially faces a major problem during an emergency given the possibility of being isolated from the surrounding communities and any subsequent resources; and

WHEREAS, the overall objective of emergency management for the City of Lyons is to ensure the effective management of response forces and resources in preparing for and responding to situations associated with natural disaster, technological incidents and national security emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyons emergency management is committed to provide effective life safety measures while reducing property loss and damage to the environment, local businesses and the community and its citizens as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyons bears certain responsibility for emergency actions and will commit all available resources to save lives, minimize injury to persons and minimize damage to property and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyons Emergency Operation Plan serves as a framework for emergency response processes and procedures to hazards threatening Linn County as a whole and the City of Lyons in particular.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT;

The City Council of the City of Lyons adopts the principles of the National Incident Management System, including the Incident Command System and the National Response Framework.

Consisting of a Basic Plan, Functional Annexes aligned with the Linn County Emergency Support Functions, and Incident Annexes, this Emergency Operations Plan provides a framework for coordinated response and recovery activities during a large-scale emergency.

The plan describes how various agencies and organizations in the City of Lyons will coordinate resources and activities with other Federal, State, local, tribal, and private-sector partners.

Any Resolutions in conflict hereof are hereby superseded.

The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Resolution shall not affect the validity of any other part of this resolution that can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Lyons.
